The group was formed following the Parish Council's decision, in late 2015, to write a Neighbourhood Development Plan. The ten members are made up of a mix of Councillors and keen volunteers:

BRYN WALTERS – GROUP CHAIR



Elected to the Parish Council in May 2015 Bryn has lived in the village for about two and a half years with his wife and daughter; Bryn is a Development Planner by profession in Derbyshire. Concerned about over development and enthusiastic about localism he is keen that through a Neighbourhood Plan Abbots Bromley can have its say!

TOM WHEELDON – VICE CHAIR



The group vice-chair really needs no introduction. Tom was born and raised in Abbots Bromley and is a focal point for so many groups and organisations across the Parish. He is passionate about his work and connections with the British Legion and the Abbots Bromley Nostalgia Group of which he is a founder member.

GREG HALL



Greg is the East Staffordshire Borough Councillor for Bagots Ward which includes Abbots Bromley Parish. A lifelong resident of Abbots Bromley Greg is a local farmer and chair of the East Staffordshire Borough Council Planning Committee.

Peter has been a resident of Abbots Bromley since 1969. He is a Highways Engineer and has an interest in the highway issues affecting the parish. An active member of the community Peter is involved with Blithfield Sailing Club; he has concerns about current planning issues.

STEPHEN PERRINS



Stephen, often referred to simply by his surname Perrins, lives outside the village having moved to Marchington Woodlands just over four years ago, so represents the wider parish within the group. He is very enthusiastic about rural issues and is keen to ensure that the neighbourhood development plan controls development in rural areas at the same time as protecting Abbots Bromley village.

Neal grew up in Abbots Bromley and returned to the village with his family 12 years ago, Neal works in construction and development. He has a keen interest in local housing need and has worked with other members of the group on the housing needs assessment consultation and evidence base.
