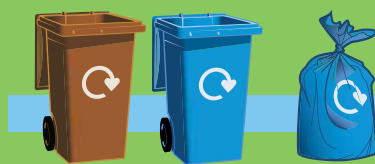

During the period 24th December to the 5th January 2013, up to 3 additional bin liners of the appropriate waste type may be put out for collection with your blue and grey bin. We will also take additional flattened cardboard at the side of your blue bin.
